


Need A Ride?

We recently received a call from C&M Publications, the company that has been printing and delivering our newsletter free of charge for many years. As mentioned previously, the "no fee" policy works when we have advertisers who help defray the cost. As you may have noticed, the folks placing an ad have cut back making C&M unable to still furnish the newsletter free of charge.

We were told that if we don't get 4 more advertisers, then we will have to pay \$50 a month to cover costs. The cost for a single space ad is \$312.00 a year and for a double space ad it is \$588.00 per year.

Anything can be advertised it doesn't have to be a company advertisement (as you already know) and the ad can be worded so folks will read it and understand. It can be thankful for God's blessings or family or whatever. Another option would be for a member or friend or family to commit to paying the \$50 a month over their regular offering.
